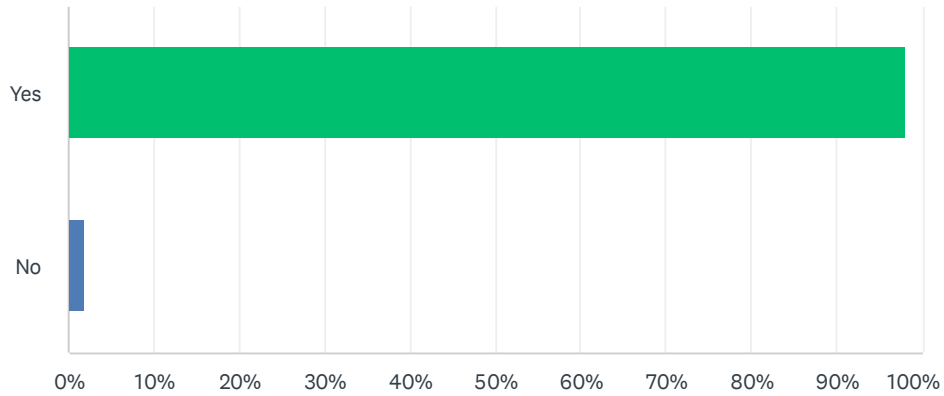


# Q1 Do you plan to enroll in Spring 2024 Semester classes?

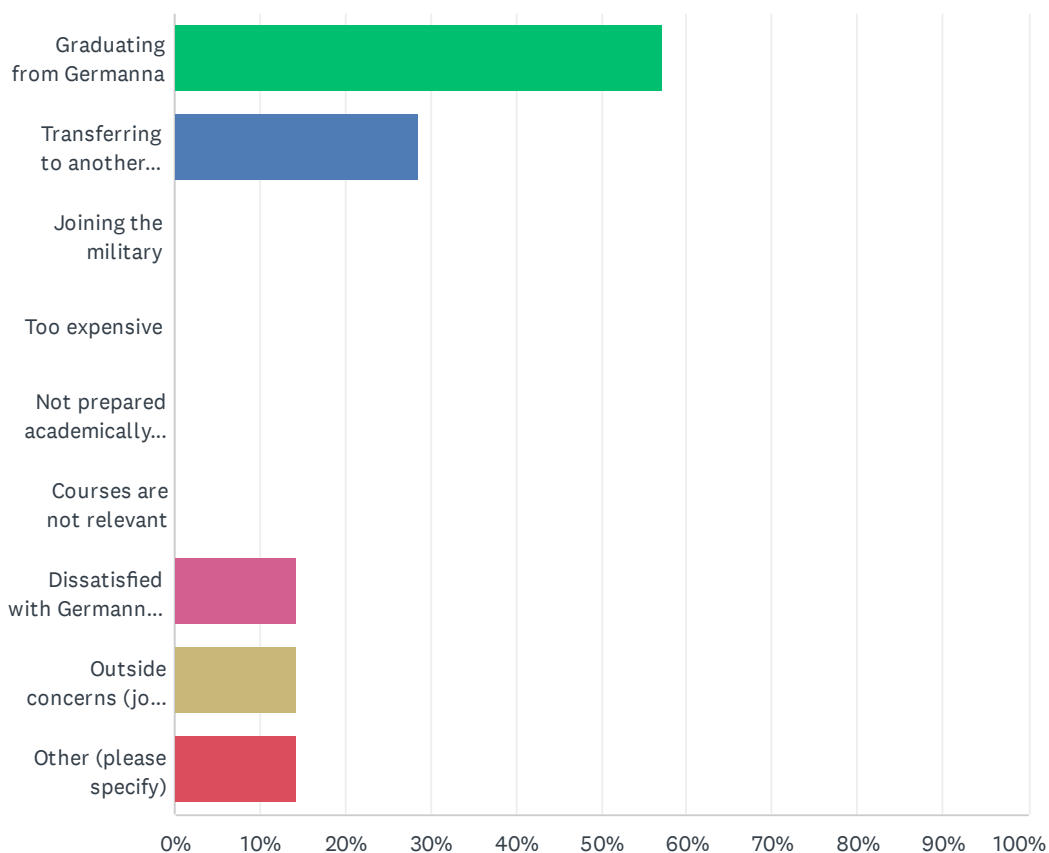

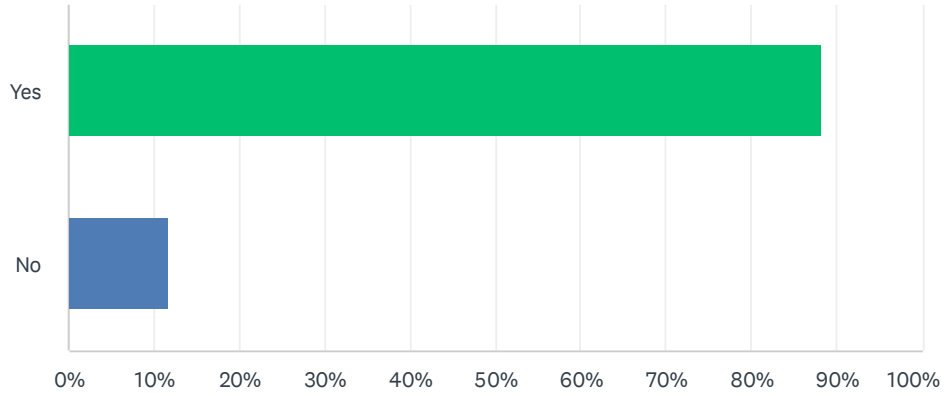

### Q3 During the Fall 2023 semester, were you able to enroll in the classes you needed?

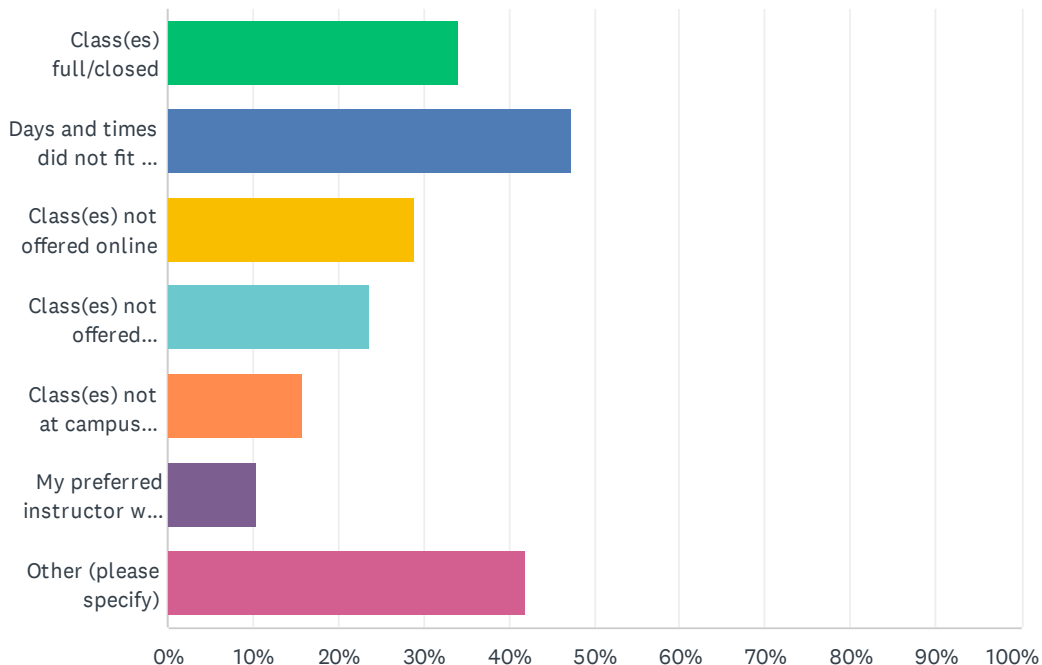

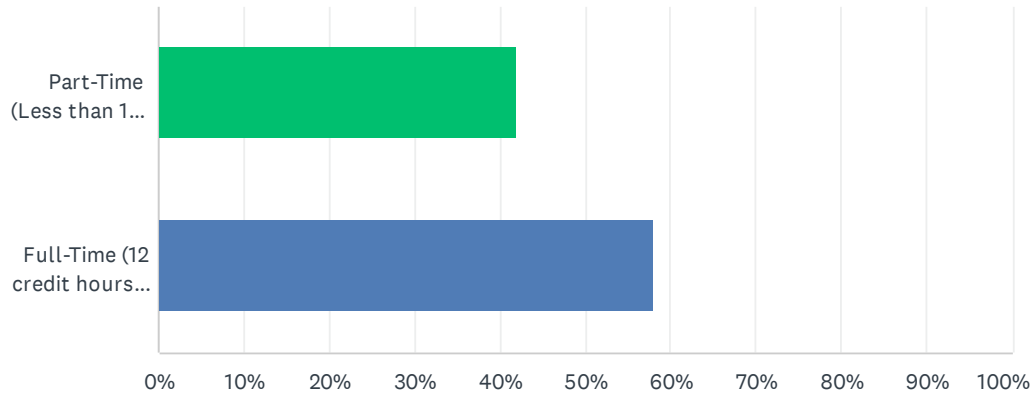

## Q5 How do you plan to attend the Spring 2024 semester?

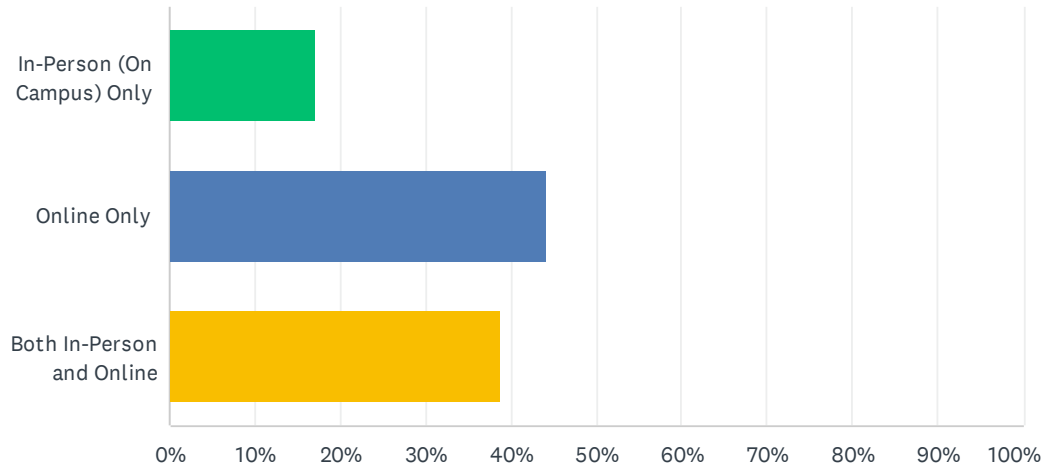

## Q6 How would you prefer to take your classes in the spring?

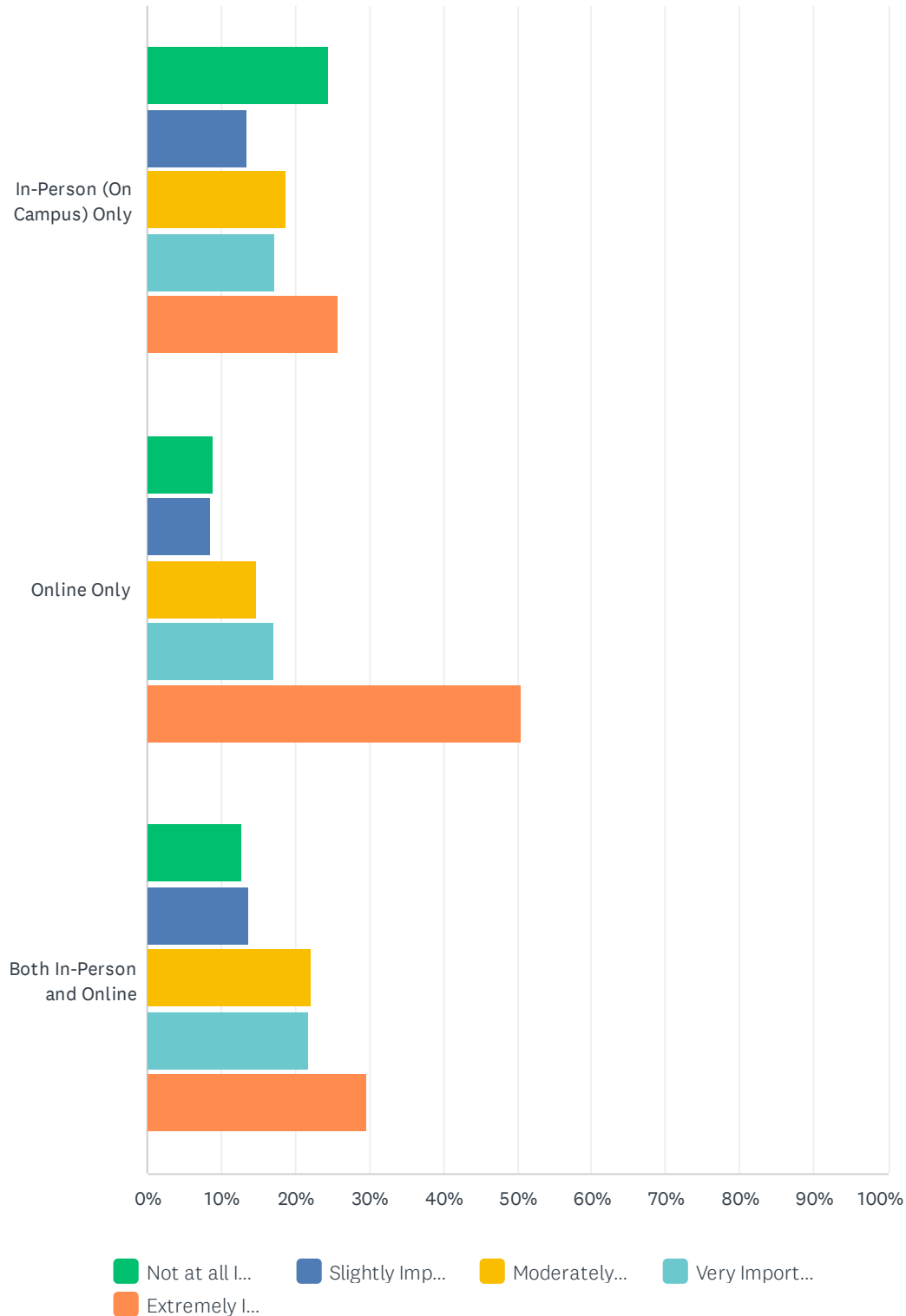

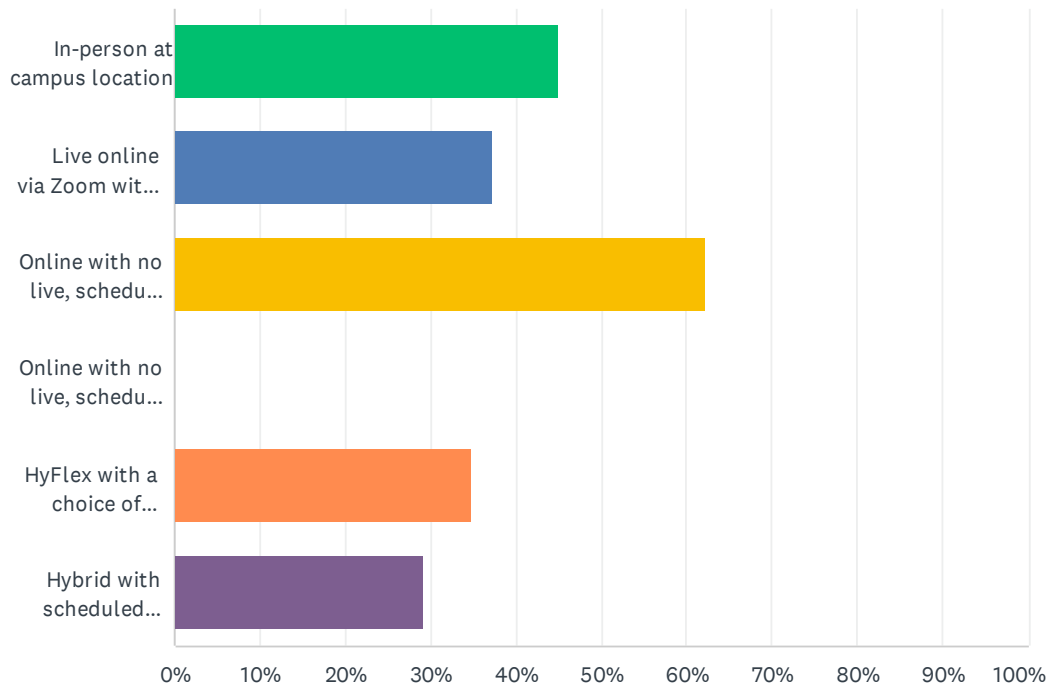

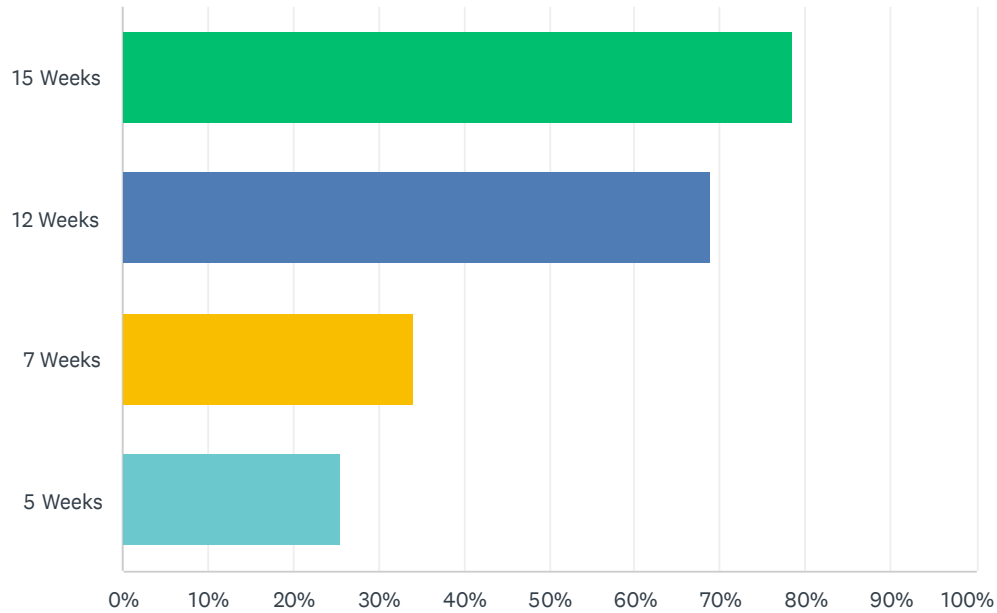

### Q9 Which offerings for course length would you consider if available? (Select all that apply.)

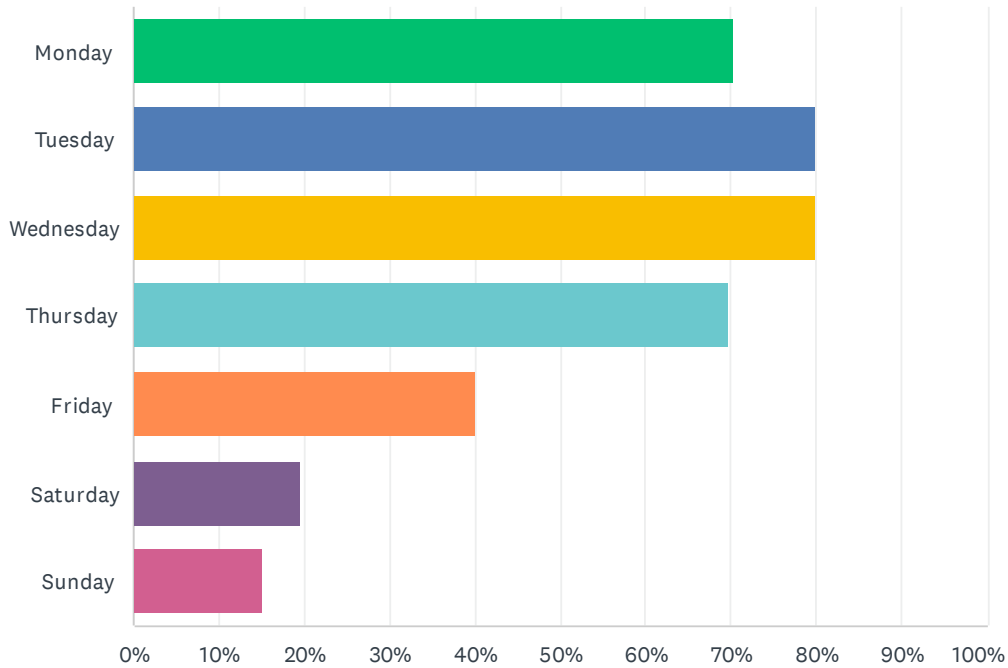

### Q10 What days do you prefer to take classes? (Select all that apply.)

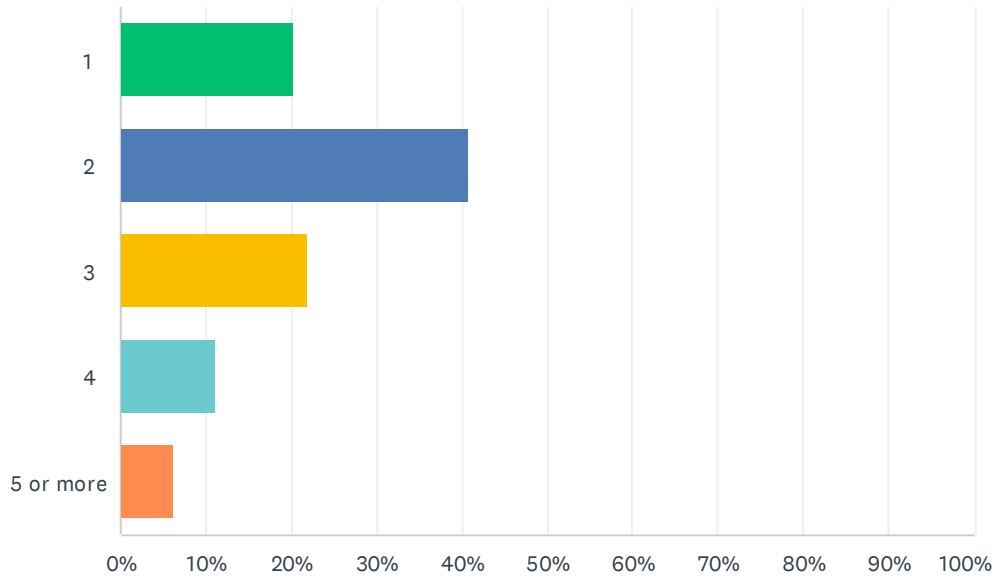

### Q11 How many days per week would you like to attend classes?

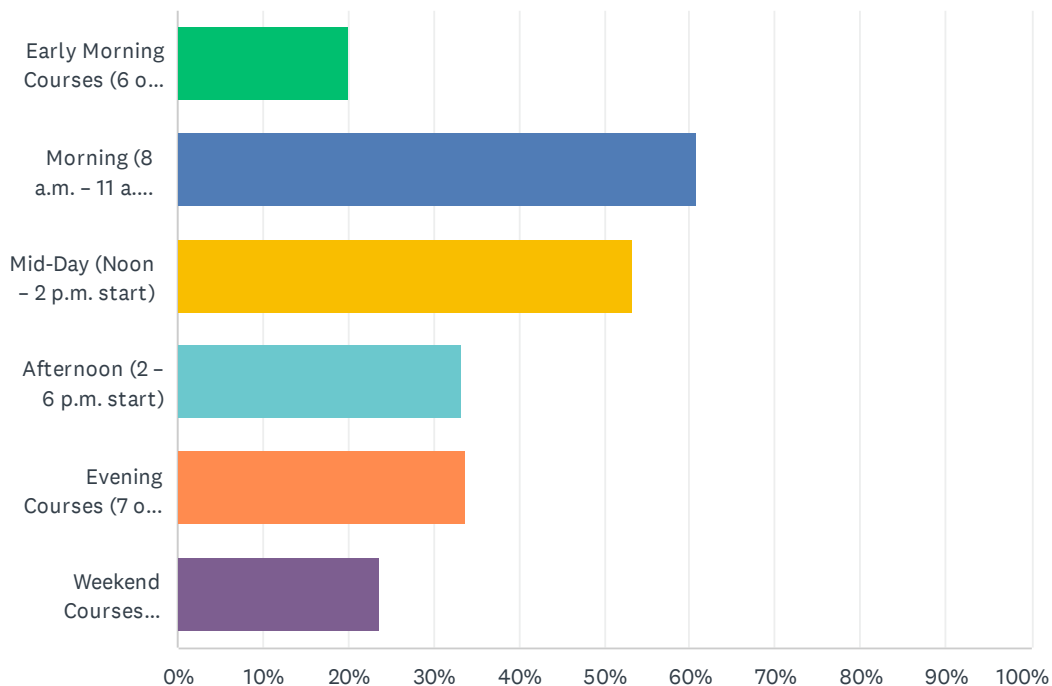

### Q12 Which offerings would you consider if available? (Select all that apply.)

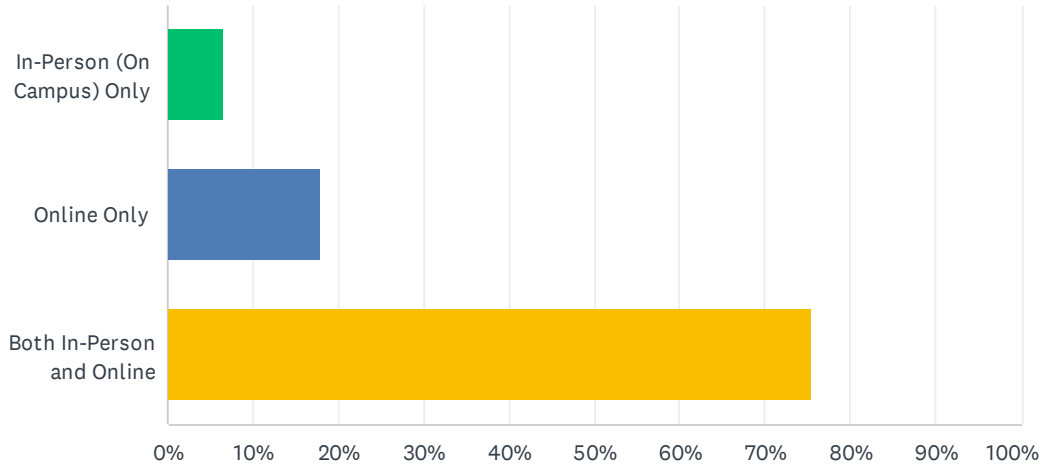

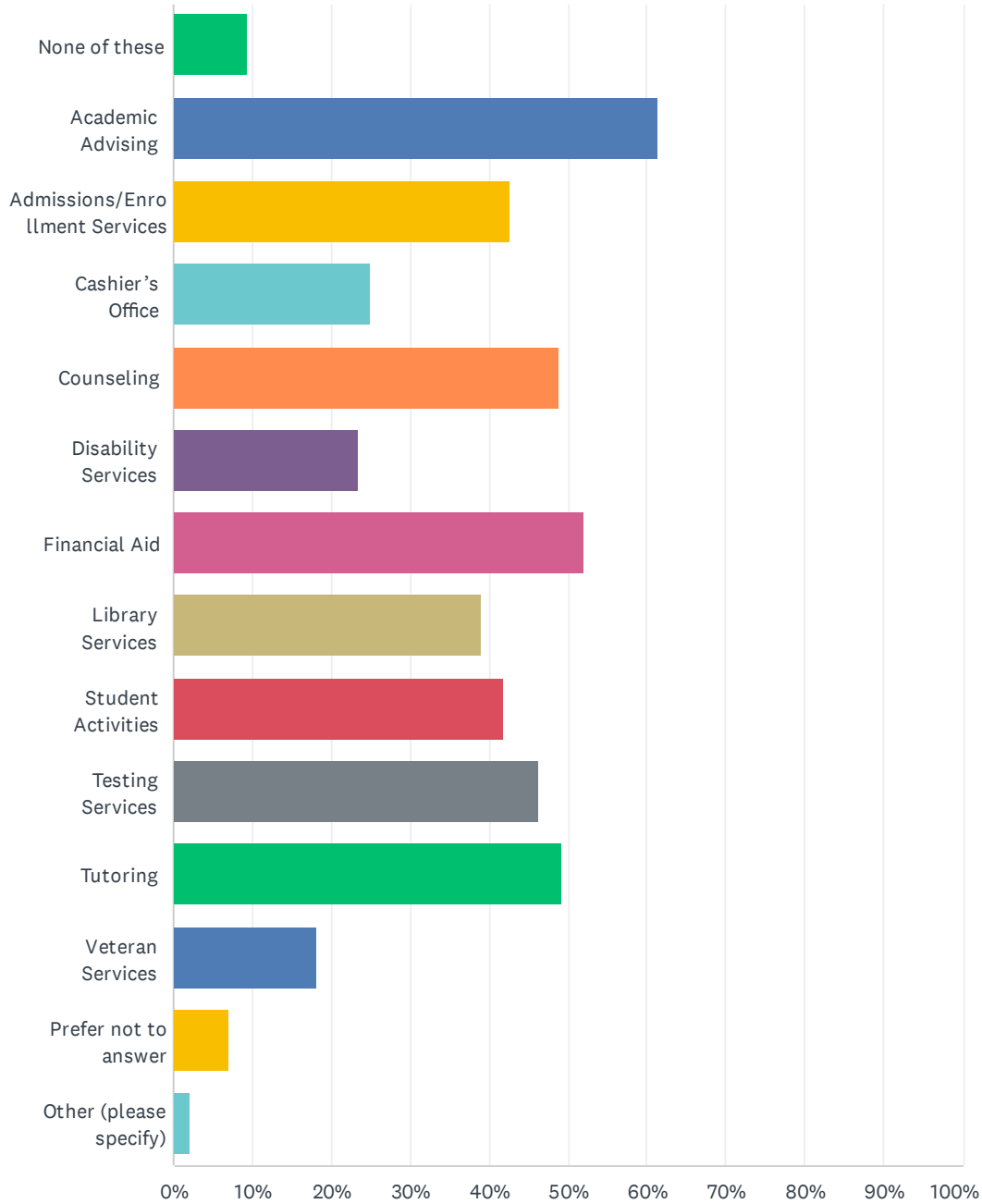

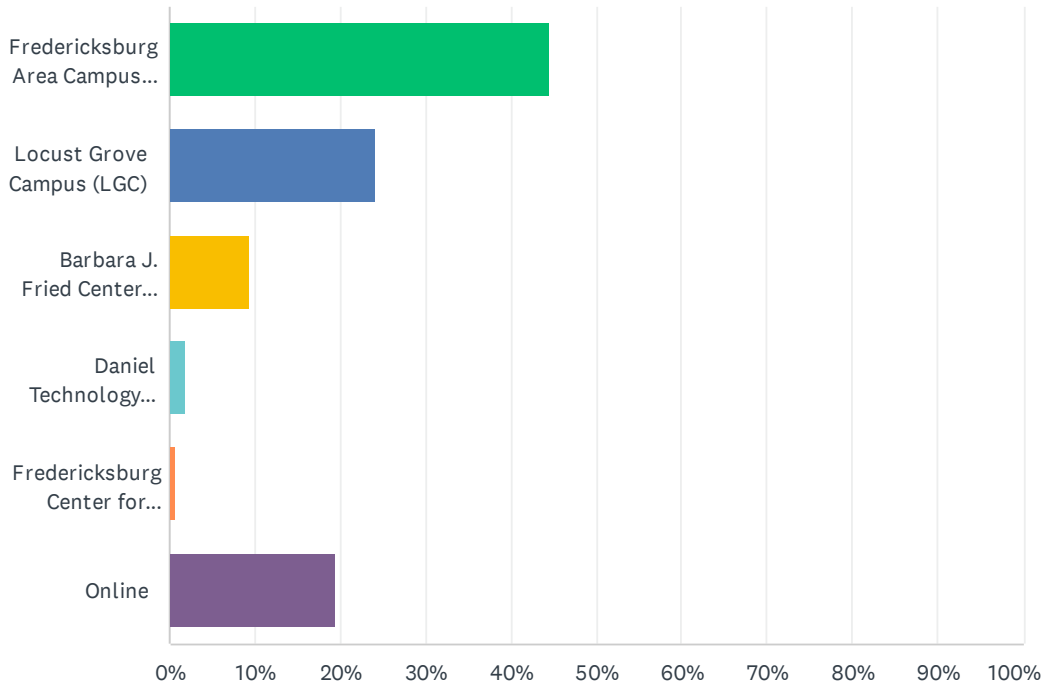

## Q16 What is your primary campus location?

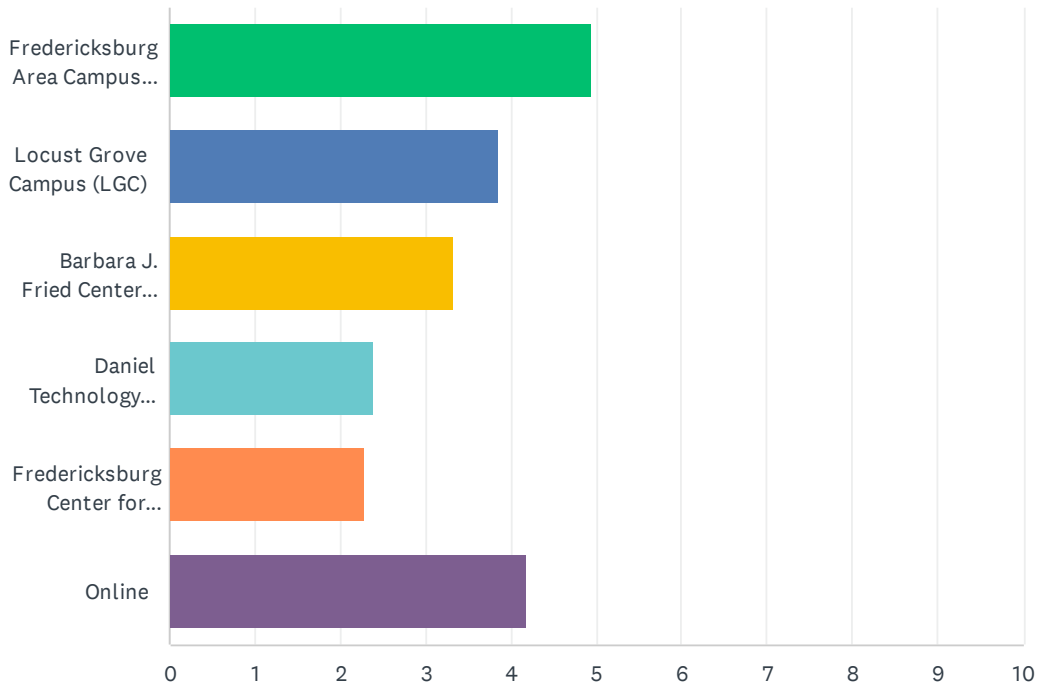

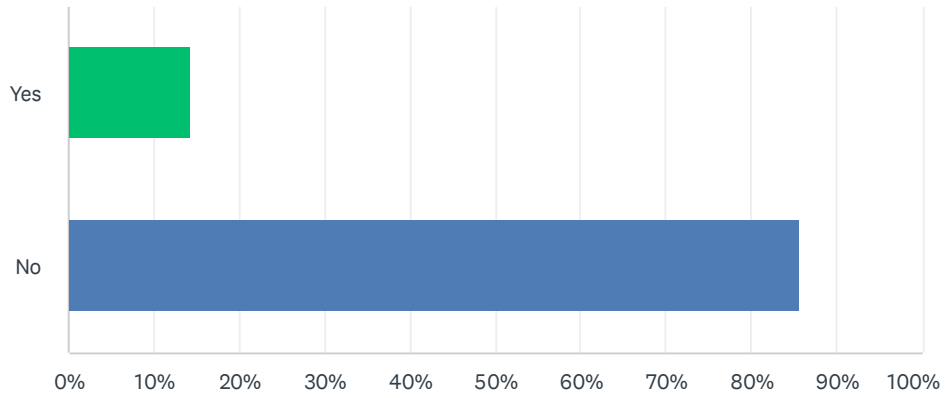

## Q20 Are you of Hispanic or Latino/a origin?

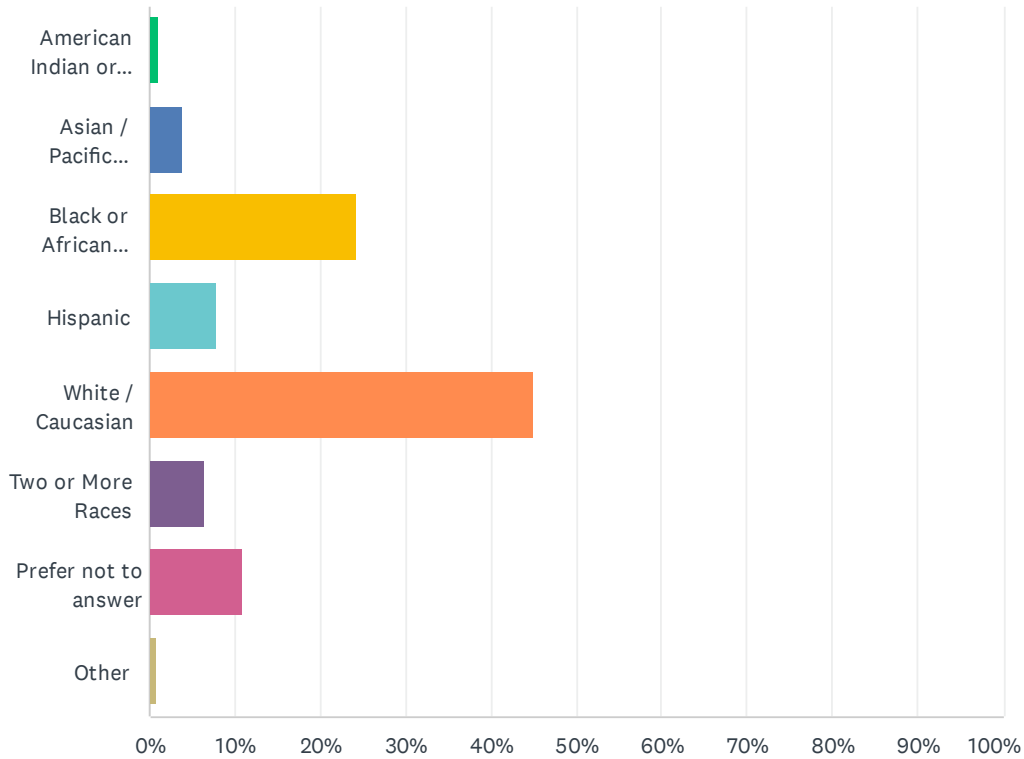

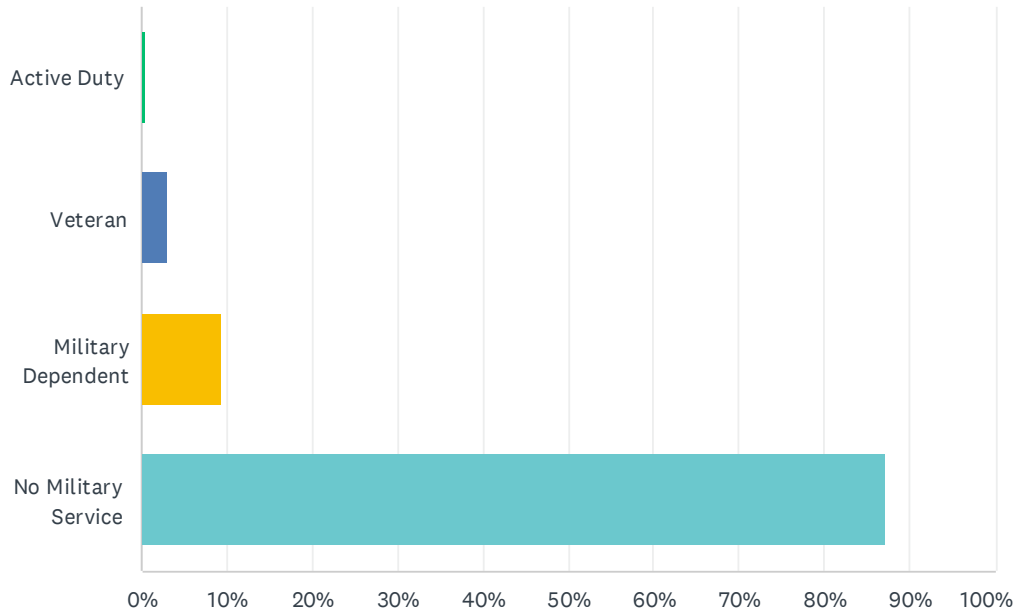

## Q22 What is your military status?

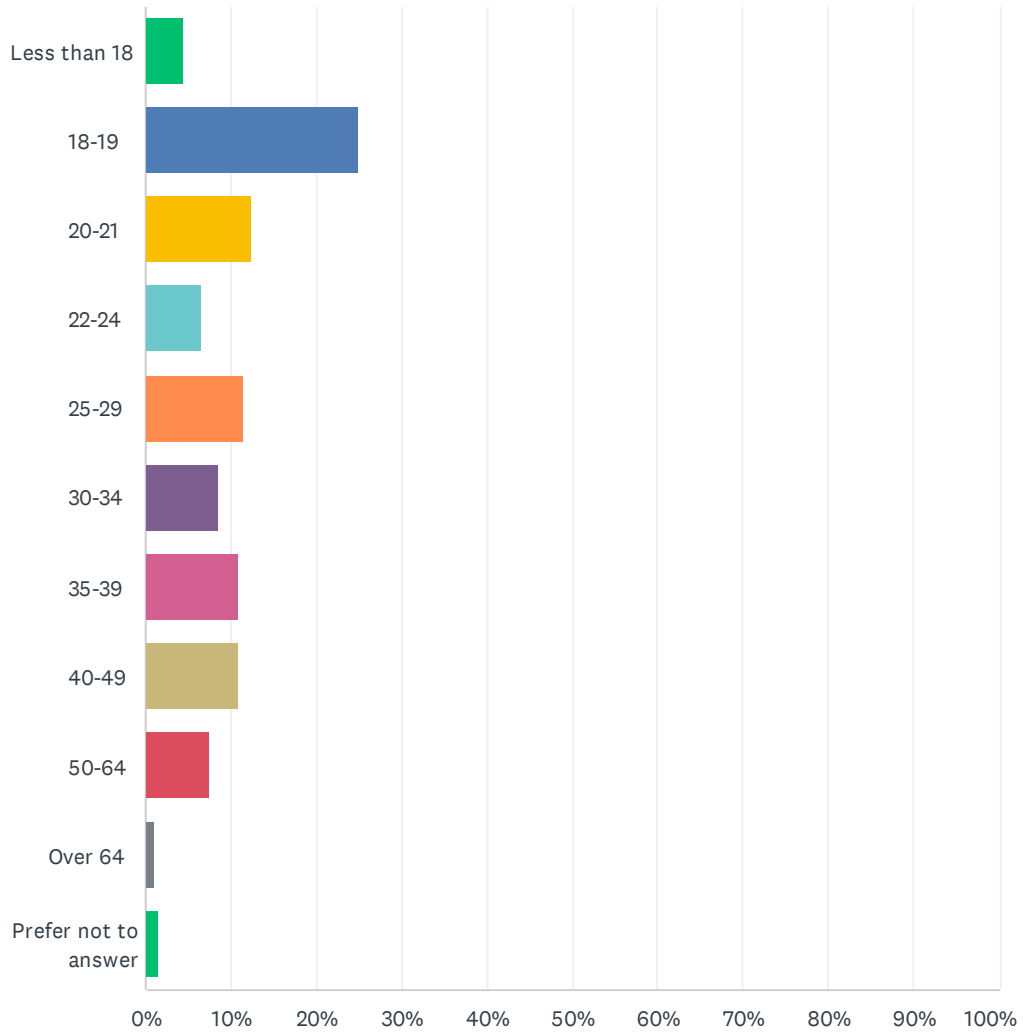
