





2 or 3 years of active duty depending on branch and service dates

Dependents Educational Assistance (CH 35)

Veteran's death or permanent and total disability as a result of service

Montgomery GI Bill® - Selected Reserve (CH 1606)

Active reservist with minimum 6-year commitment after 6/30/85
