

### ITP 120: How to Download and Create Java Projects in Eclipse

Students enrolled in ITP 120 will learn Java programming, and this often includes the use of Eclipse Java IDE. This handout guides students through the processes of downloading the Eclipse Java IDE and creating Java project files.




#### **Downloading Eclipse Java IDE**

First, go to the Eclipse website at <u>https://www.eclipse.org/</u> and click the "Download" button at the top.



On the Eclipse Foundation website, look at the lower left of the screen to find "Get Eclipse IDE," which is followed by the current year; the version is updated annually. Click "Download x86\_64," and it will direct you to another page. Select the "Download" button on that new page.



Once the IDE has finished downloading, go to the computer's file manager. Select the "Downloads" folder and select "IDE download."



The Eclipse Installer Manager will open with a list of Eclipse offered IDEs. At the top of the list, select "Eclipse IDE for Java Developers."

After selecting the correct IDE, the installation pane will appear. Keep all the defaults selected and click "Install." If the terms and conditions appear, click "Accept Now" after reading the legal agreement. Then the download will begin, but it may take several minutes. Once Eclipse IDE for Java Developers has been downloaded, select the green "Launch" button," which will open the IDE.



The IDE will provide a default workspace folder, but it can be changed by clicking "Browse" and selecting a previously created folder. In this sample, the default workspace has been kept. Click "Launch."



The IDE will once again begin to boot up. Now that the IDE has been downloaded, the next sections will explain how to create a Java project folder, a package, and a class in Eclipse.


#### Create a Java Project

If the project pane is not visible, select the top icon on the left pane.

The first item to create is a Java Project. This will store the package and class files for assignments. Go to "File" at the top left-hand side of the page, and hover over the word "New." This will display the options for creation; select "Java Project."





Provide the project with a name. Most project names are in Camel casing, which means that they start with a lowercase letter. Once the project is named, keep the defaults that Eclipse provides. Then select "Finish."

#### Create a Package

A package file is used to group related classes and to help avoid errors when repeating class names in different Java projects. Go to "File," click "New," and then select "Package."






#### **Create a Class**

The final step is to create a Class. Go to "File" at the top left-hand side of the page, and hover over the word "New." The options for creation will be displayed; select "Class."



This is where you will write your code; the title of the Class will also be in Camel casing. Eclipse also provides the main method inside of each class file. Go to the checkboxes below and select the main method. Then click "Finish."



You can create as many classes as necessary. To do so, refer to the beginning of this section.
