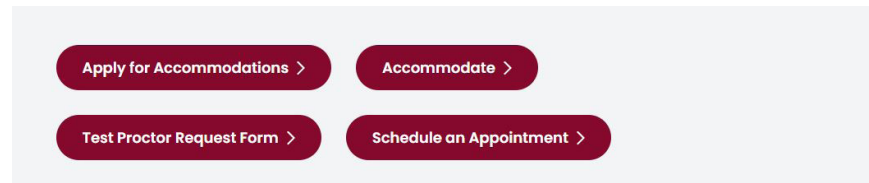
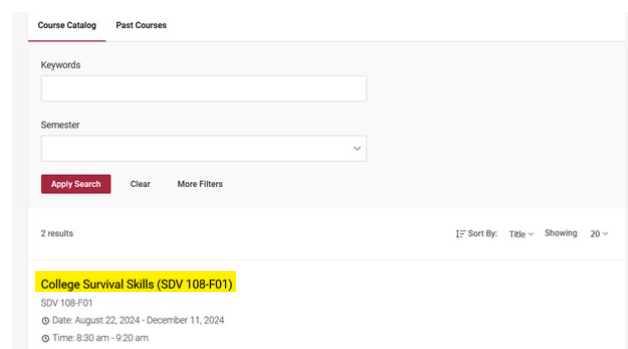
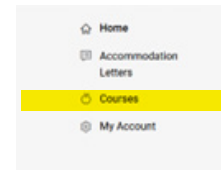


ACCESSING STUDENT ACCOMMODATIONS

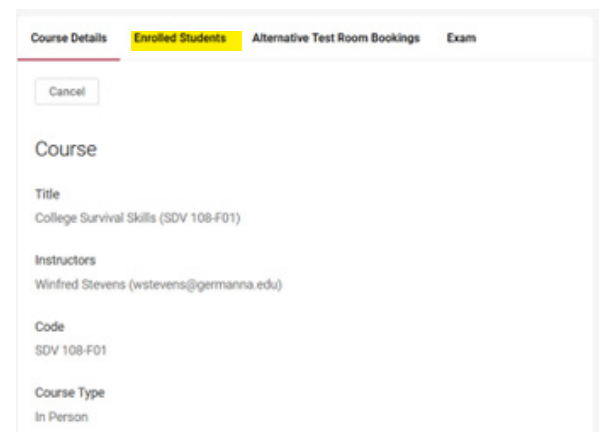
Start by clicking on **Accommodate**.



On the main screen, there are two options to view your students who have accommodations in place. The first option is to click on the course where the student has accommodations.



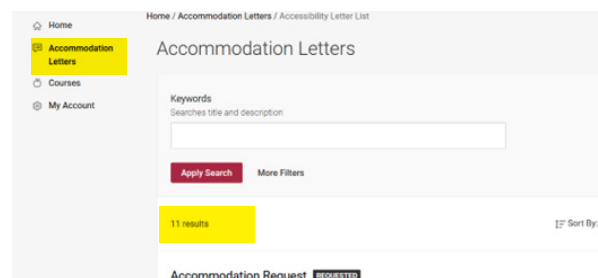
After you click on “Courses,” you will see a list of classes that you are teaching.



Next, click on the “Enrolled Students” tab at the top of the page.

Then, scroll down to find the students who have accommodations. If a student with accommodations does not show up or is not enrolled in your class, please contact the Office of Accessibility Resources.

- Accommodations:
- Ability to have tests, quizzes and exams read aloud
 - Extended time on Quizzes, Tests, and Exams/2.0x
 - Meeting with instructors one-on-one
 - New Assignment Due Date
 - Use of a note taker



The second option is to view all students with accommodations in one list. You can do this by clicking on “Accommodation Letters” to see the students listed. If you don’t see a particular student, please contact the Office of Accessibility Resources.
